Itinerary

1 Arrive Barcelona

Upon arrival in Barcelona Airport, meet your Sarang Tradlink representative in the arrivals hall (meeting time 12.01pm) or a pre-arranged meeting point. From here, we will board our coach and begin our adventure. Our first stop is Montjuïc Hill, where a scenic cable car ride offers sweeping views of the harbor and city skyline a perfect backdrop for photographs. (Note: castle entry at the summit is not included.) On our way down, we will pass by Barcelona's Olympic Stadium.

We will then head to the city center for an Indian lunch, followed by free time along the lively boulevard of Las Ramblas a perfect for souvenir shopping, enjoying a café, or soaking in the atmosphere. Later, we attend an intimate Flamenco show, where passionate dancing, masterful guitar, and soulful singing create a mesmerizing experience. (Please note: the Flamenco show may be scheduled on Day 2 instead.) (L, D)

2 Barcelona – Montserrat – Barcelona

Explore Barcelona's history with a guided city tour, marveling at the exterior of the Sagrada Família, followed by a lunch. The afternoon unfolds in the beautiful Montserrat, a mountain retreat known for its serenity and religious significance, before returning to Barcelona. (B, L, D)

3 Barcelona – Valencia

Travel to Valencia, delving into its vibrant city centre upon arrival. Discover landmarks like the Gateway Towers and innovative City of Arts & Sciences with a local guide. Conclude the day with either of Spanish or Indian dinner and retire to your hotel for the night. (B, D)

4 Valencia – Malaga

Begin with a visit to L'Oceanogràfic, exploring a variety of marine ecosystems. Explore exhibits showcasing marine ecosystems from the Mediterranean to the Arctic, and marvel at the impressive Dolphinarium with its enormous water capacity. In the early afternoon, we will depart for Malaga. Upon arrival, we check-in to our hotel and enjoy dinner together. (B, D)

5 Malaga

After breakfast, enjoy a panoramic tour of Malaga, including the Museo Carmen Thyssen, Pompidou Centre, Castillo de Gibralfaro, and the Centre d'Art Contemporain. Stroll through Plaza de la Marina, Paseo del Parque, and, weather permitting, relax at Playa de la Malagueta. Enjoy free time before dinner and an overnight stay in Malaga. (B, D)

6 Malaga – Seville – Lisbon

We journey to Seville, the capital of Andalusia. Our guided tour takes in the magnificent Alcázar, the tranquil gardens of María Luisa Park, the beautiful Plaza de España, the historic Torre del Oro, the colorful Maestranza bullring, and the majestic Cathedral. We then continue our drive into Portugal, arriving in Lisbon for dinner and an overnight stay. (B, D)

7 Lisbon

Lisbon, the "City of Seven Hills," awaits us today. After breakfast, we explore the Alfama district, wandering through its narrow lanes before heading to a hilltop castle for panoramic city views. We continue to the Belém district to see the UNESCO-listed Jerónimos Monastery and Belém Tower. At the Monument of Discoveries, we will reflect on Portugal's seafaring past, and finish with a tasting of the famous pastel de nata. Lunch and dinner will be at local restaurants. (B, L, D)

8 Lisbon – Porto

After breakfast, we depart for Porto, a charming riverside city famed for its wine and history. Our guided tour includes the Clérigos Tower and Church, the stunning Lello Bookshop, the Sé Cathedral, and a visit to a port wine cellar complete with a tasting session. Dinner will be served before we settle in for the night in Porto. (B, L, D)

9 Porto – Madrid

After breakfast, we check-out and make our way to Madrid. On arrival, we will enjoy a scenic drive along the Gran Vía, the city's vibrant main thoroughfare. Dinner will be served at a local restaurant before checking into our hotel. (B, D)

10 Madrid – Toledo – Madrid

Today begins with a journey to Toledo, a UNESCO World Heritage city where Christian, Muslim, and Jewish influences intertwine. Our guided tour will include the Cathedral of Toledo, Puente de San Martín, and the city's labyrinth of cobbled streets. We will also visit a sword factory, showcasing Toledo's famed craftsmanship. After returning to Madrid for a light lunch, we visit the Royal Palace, once the residence of Spanish monarchs, with its opulent halls and sweeping river views. As we leave, we will pass the world-renowned Prado Museum. Dinner follows in the evening. (B, L, D)

11 Madrid Departure

After breakfast, we enjoy a final morning in Madrid with a stroll through Parque del Buen Retiro, a peaceful escape in the heart of the city. Once a royal retreat, it is now a public park filled with monuments, gardens, and cultural events. We will have lunch at a local Indian restaurant before transferring to Madrid Airport. (Flight not included) bringing our unforgettable journey to a close. Airport transfers will be conducted on smaller vehicles / coaches. (B, L)

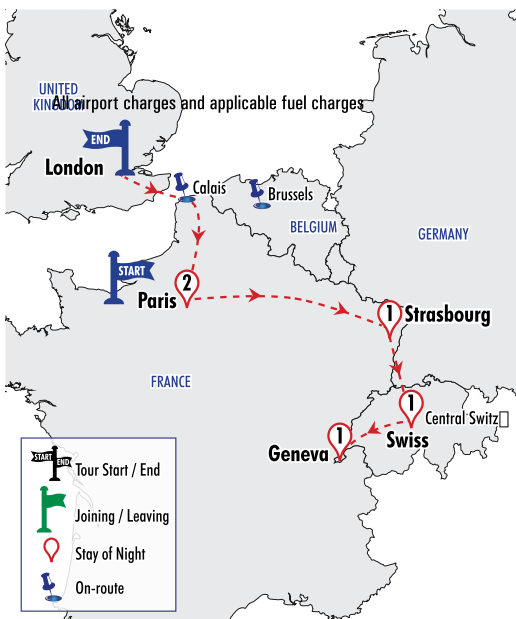

Itinerary

1 London – Calais – Paris

Today morning, depart towards Dover for your crossing to Calais; The crossing on the ferry will last approx. 90 Minutes; 40 minutes if the crossing is from the Euro Tunnel train. Once we are in mainland Europe, we make our way directly towards Paris. We embark on the famous "Bateaux" cruises of Paris for our one-hour cruise along the River Seine, we cover the stunning architecture that Paris has to offer on sights such as the Grand Palais, Petite Palais, Pont Alexandre 3rd bridge, National Assembly, Invalides and of course the spectacular Eiffel Tower. We will then visit the new BAPS Paris mandir site. Later, check-in to your hotel.

2 BAPS Paris Mandir

After early breakfast, we proceed to the new BAPS Hindu temple; spend the morning / early afternoon at the Mandir. In the afternoon we proceed to Paris for a city tour: you will see the Champs Elysees, Arc du Triomphe, Ritz hotel, Place Vendome. We then visit the renowned Eiffel Tower. Prepare to ascend this magnificent landmark and take in sweeping views of the city from the best available level-whether it's the stunning second floor or, when accessible, the topmost Level 3, offering breathtaking 360° panoramas. And here's a special treat-if access to the top floor (Level 3) is available on the day of our visit, you will enjoy this upgrade absolutely complimentary! It's our way of adding a little extra sparkle to your Parisian experience. Early evening we return to the new BAPS Paris Mandir, late night return to hotel. (B)

3 Paris – Strasbourg

This morning, meet your Sarang Tradlink Manager at hotel reception; check-out and proceed to Strasbourg. We will make comfort stops on route. Arrive early evening and check into your hotel. (B, D)

4 Black Forest – Lake Titisee – Rhine Falls – Lucerne

After breakfast, depart towards Germany. We then arrive at the small town of Titisee-Neustadt in the middle of the Black Forest. Among dark fir trees, high hills, spectacular cliffs, and gentle valleys sits the largest natural lake in the Black Forest, Titisee. Here, enjoy some free time to wander the quaint streets, relax by the lake, or shop for locally made cuckoo clocks and a varied selection of souvenirs. Continuing our journey to Schaffhausen, Switzerland on the river Rhine, next to the German border. On arrival, take the time to admire the prime tourist attraction of the Rhine Falls, Europe's largest open-plain waterfalls. You have the time to enjoy a quick trip to the center of falls on the erosion-resistant rock, admiring the beauty from the banks of the River Rhine with the Wörth Castle in the backdrop. We re-join our coach and make our way towards Central Switzerland. In Lucerne, spend time admiring Lake Lucerne, or take a wonderful walk around the Old Town in the pretty cobbled streets. Don't forget to walk and view the Chapel Bridge and visit the Lion Monument. (B, L, D)

5 Mt Titlis – Interlaken – Geneva

After breakfast, we ascend 10,000ft to the summit of Mt. Titlis. We take a small cable car before we board the world's first revolving cable car, the Titlis Rotair. The Rotair completes one full revolution as we ascend to the top of Mt. Titlis, offering a breathtaking 360-degree view of the Uri Alps. At the summit, you can not only enjoy panoramic views of the Swiss landscapes, purchase souvenirs and walk the highest Cliff Walk, a suspended pedestrian bridge along the cliff of Mount Titlis 3,000m above sea level. Spend the morning playing in the snow and visiting the ice caves. On Mt. Titlis, you can also enjoy the optional Ice Flyer

(subject to operation). We head down in the early afternoon for a well-deserved Indian lunch after the morning's activities. We board our coach and make our way from Engelberg to the beautiful city of Interlaken, a small town nestled between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz. Spend time shopping for souvenirs along the high street or simply admire the stunning views of the Bernese Alps. Kursaal Garden, where you will find a 350 Kg statue of the renowned Indian filmmaker, the late Yash Chopra. In the evening, once we reach Geneva, we first visit the "Jardin Anglais," known as the English Gardens, we stop for photos of the National Monument featuring Lady Geneva and Lady Helvetica. We also see the iconic Flower Clock, an outdoor flower clock designed in 1955, made with colorful blooms that change seasonally, and finally, the Jet d'Eau (subject to operation), a fountain lit up at night, pumping half a cubic meter of water per second 140m into the air. We then head towards the United Nations of Geneva (UNOG) for our second photo stop. The UNOG is the second-largest of the four major office sites of the United Nations and is situated in the Palais des Nations building. Capture an amazing picture containing all the flags of the countries of the United Nations. We finish our quick trip to Geneva. We enjoy a buffet Indian dinner before settling in for the night. (B, L, D)

6 Geneva

After breakfast, check out and proceed to the airport for your return flight home. (B)
